Watch and sing along to the song: [He's Able](#)

Verse discovery: I will bring you to the land I swore with uplifted hand to give to Abraham, to Isaac and to Jacob. Exodus 6:8

Lesson focus: In Exodus 5 we see that Moses has approached Pharaoh to ask him to let his people go, and instead of responding positively, Pharaoh has been even more unfair to the Israelites. Maybe you have been in a situation where you feel God is leading you and instead circumstances have become even more difficult and you wonder if God is still faithful or if He has forgotten you. God had an answer for Moses and for all of us, and that is He is indeed faithful, He has not forgotten us and He will fulfil the promises that He made. [Read Exodus 5:22-6:8]

2. Moses Sees the Promised Land: Materials needed: 12" x 18" yellow construction paper for each child, scraps of different colored paper, cotton batting, glue, crayons, marker. Hand out yellow paper, this is the background. Have your child create a beautiful picture of the Promised Land by using scraps of paper, bits of this and that any way they choose. Use a small amount of cotton batting which can be pulled apart to create two small clouds. Don't forget to make Moses at the top of the mountain. Label Mt. Nebo and Pisgah. Write "Moses Sees The Promised Land" and "Deuteronomy 34" at the top of the paper.
