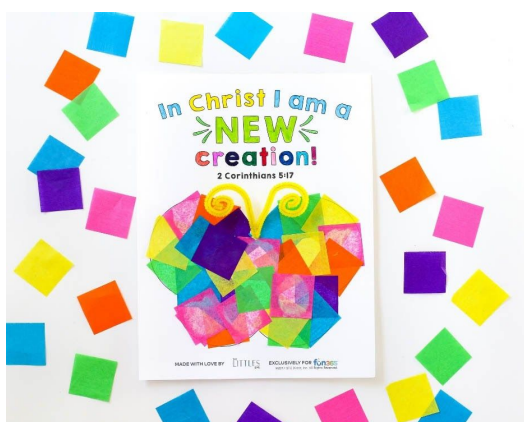
Watch and sing along to the song: [If I Were a Butterfly](#)

Here is a short skit you can watch based on being a new creation in Christ:
[2 Corinthians 5:17](#)

VERSE DISCOVERY: Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, the new creation has come: The old has gone, the new is here! (2 Corinthians 5:17)

The idea of being “born again” is a tricky concept for adults and kids alike. In this context, children are encouraged to consider how being a Christian gives us a new sort of life, comparable to a caterpillar changing into a butterfly. These crafts emphasize that concept. As you work on them, feel free to share [this devotional](#) with your child on how we can become a new creation in Christ. Have fun!

1. I Am a New Creation Mosaic Butterfly: Start by printing the [‘In Christ I am a New Creation’ printable](#) onto white cardstock. Kids can color the picture and then use a glue stick to attach tissue paper (or coloured paper) squares onto the butterfly. Finish by bending a pipe cleaner in half to create the butterfly's antennae and attach it with glue. Once the butterfly is complete, say 2 Corinthians 5:17 out loud together.
