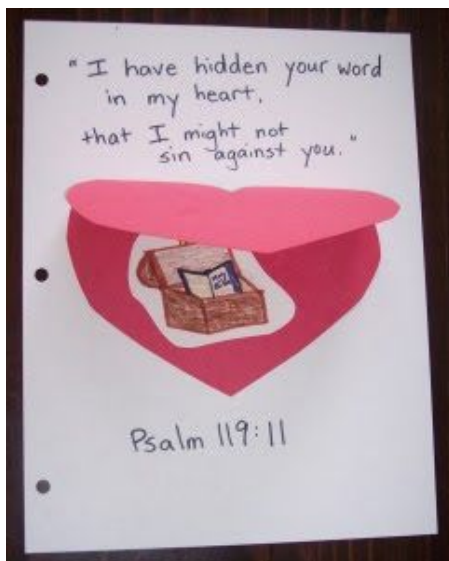
Here's a short video you can watch with your child about King Josiah: [God's Story: Josiah](#)

Verse discovery: I have hidden your word in my heart that I might not sin against you. (Psalm 119:11)

Lesson focus: This week's activities are about King Josiah and how excited he was when the Book of the Law was found in the Temple. When they found the lost scroll, it was like finding a treasure. Talk with your child about how special the Bible is and how we "hide" it (the NASB says "treasure" it) in our hearts. Read 2 Kings 22:1-20 and [click here for a full Bible lesson on King Josiah.](#)

Additional activities

1. Hide your word in my heart: This craft both "hides" a Bible inside a heart, but also conveys the idea of the Bible as treasure. Draw a treasure chest with a Bible inside. Then glued it inside a folding heart.



2. Find the Bible: To emphasize how precious God's Word is, play a game of "hot and cold" where you hide a Bible and have your child(ren) look for it. Take turns hiding the Bible over and over and looking for your treasure.
