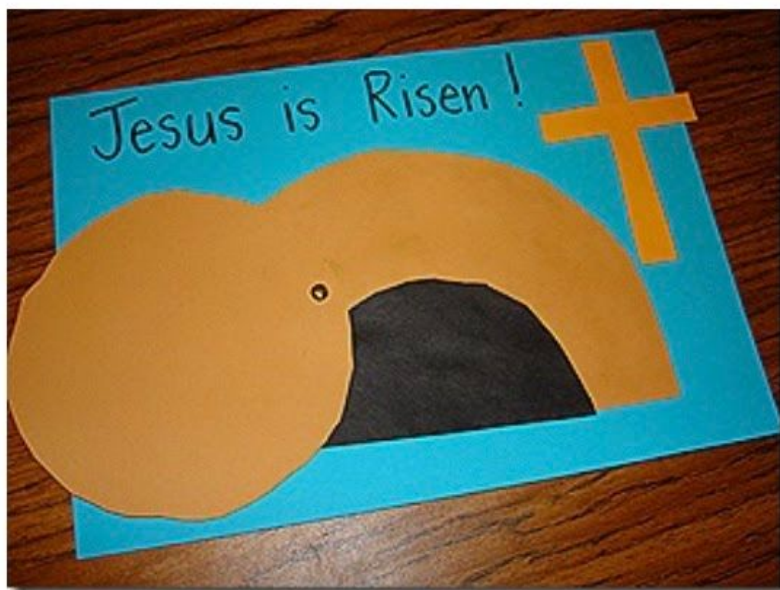
Here is a craft you can do as you chat about Easter Sunday with your kids. You will see the craft suggests using a brad (small bit of wire) to attach the stone to the tomb, but anything that will let the stone swing on the paper will work. (Eg, staple).

Bible Verse

*He is not here. He has risen, just as He said.
Matthew 28:6a*

Craft

Make a picture showing Jesus' empty tomb!
Draw two half circles (one small and one large) for the tomb. Draw a circle for the stone that was rolled away. Let your little one cut out the pieces. Glue to tomb onto construction paper and attach the stone with a brad.



Finally here's an Easter prayer:

Dear God,
Thank you that Jesus came and died on the cross for us!
Thank you that He was buried in the tomb.
Thank you that He was raised from the dead!
Thank you that Jesus is alive forever!
